WELCOME TO FROSTBURG

Home to Frostburg State University and nicknamed the "Mountain City", Frostburg boasts a bustling Main Street fittingly located up the hill from the Great Allegheny Passage trail access area. The town at the top is definitely worth the climb!

From the trailhead, first follow the switchback to Depot Street, the far terminus of the Western Maryland Scenic Railroad. Upon the train's arrival to the depot, a turntable impressively reverses it for the trip back to Cumberland.

You can park your bike (or ride to the top) and take the set of stairs from the Depot into town. You will find that Frostburg reflects the evolving styles of America's Main Streets over the past 200 years.

Wild Things Restaurant and Bar is right at the top of the hill and can satisfy your hunger and thirst. The Mountain City Coffeehouse & Creamery breathes new life into a historic gothic building with its organic, local foods and free trade coffees. It's one of several great eateries in town. Other interesting spots include Mountain City Traditional Arts, Main Street Books, McFarland Candies, Frostburg Community Library, Spectrum Designs, FSU Bobcat Store and the General Arts Store. Or stay in town at the historic Failingler's Hotel Gunter, The Trail Inn, or Charlie's Motel.

Frostburg is a designated Maryland Arts & Entertainment District, which includes several galleries, the historic Palace Theatre and the Frostburg Museum. The town's roots are as a stagecoach stop along the National Road, and the four-season community remains a welcoming and vibrant community today.

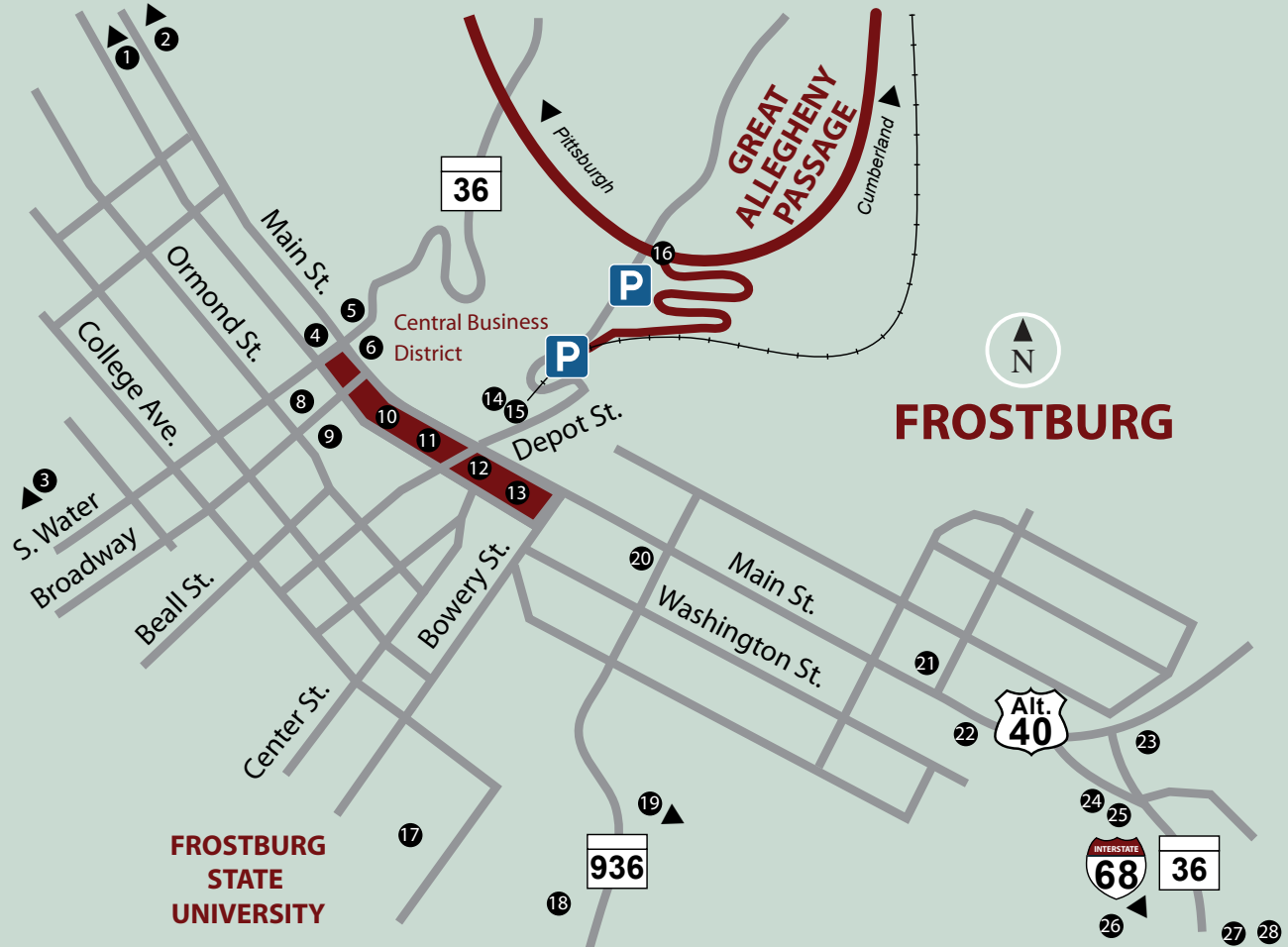
